How does HUD calculate community funding for a CoC?	HUD is making available approximately \$2.1 billion in Fiscal Year 2018 for the CoC Program. The distribution of funds will depend largely on CoC determined priorities, HUD selection priorities, overall demand, and renewal eligibility.
