Dear AK-500 CoC Applicants,

Thank you to all the organizations who submitted project applications to the Anchorage Continuum of Care (CoC). Attached is the final ranking of projects.

This year we received nine renewal applications. Three of these applications are dedicated funding specifically for CoC Planning, Coordinated Entry and HMIS. Six additional renewal applications were received and one new Domestic Violence (DV) bonus application. We did not receive any overall bonus applications. The amount requested by projects equals Anchorage's annual renewal demand.

The CoC's Ranking and Review Committee used HUD's Project Rating and Ranking Tool to rank all applications. Projects were ranked on overall project scores and placed in Tiers. For this year's competition, HUD set Tier 1 at 94% and Tier 2 at 6% of the annual renewal demand. CoC planning funds are not part of either Tier 1 or Tier 2. The DV Bonus Project was scored and placed in Tier 2 (please see the 2018 NOFA for more information on the DC Bonus placement).
