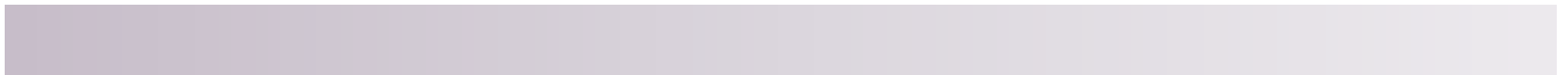

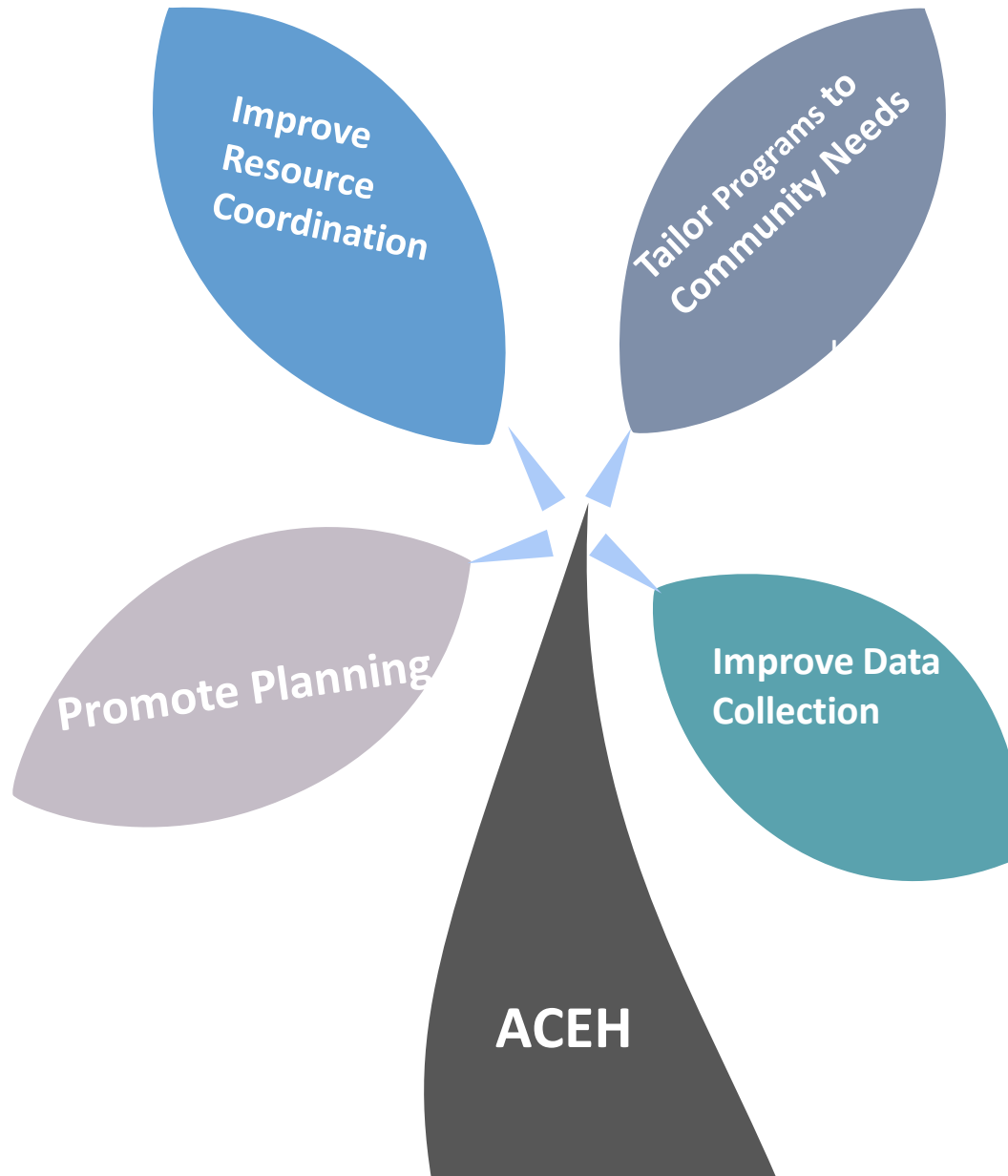

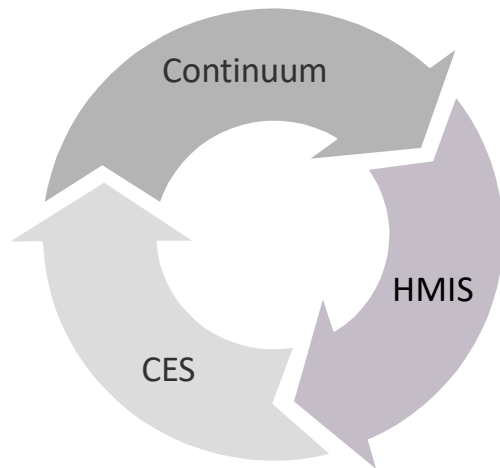

Role of a Continuum of Care (CoC)

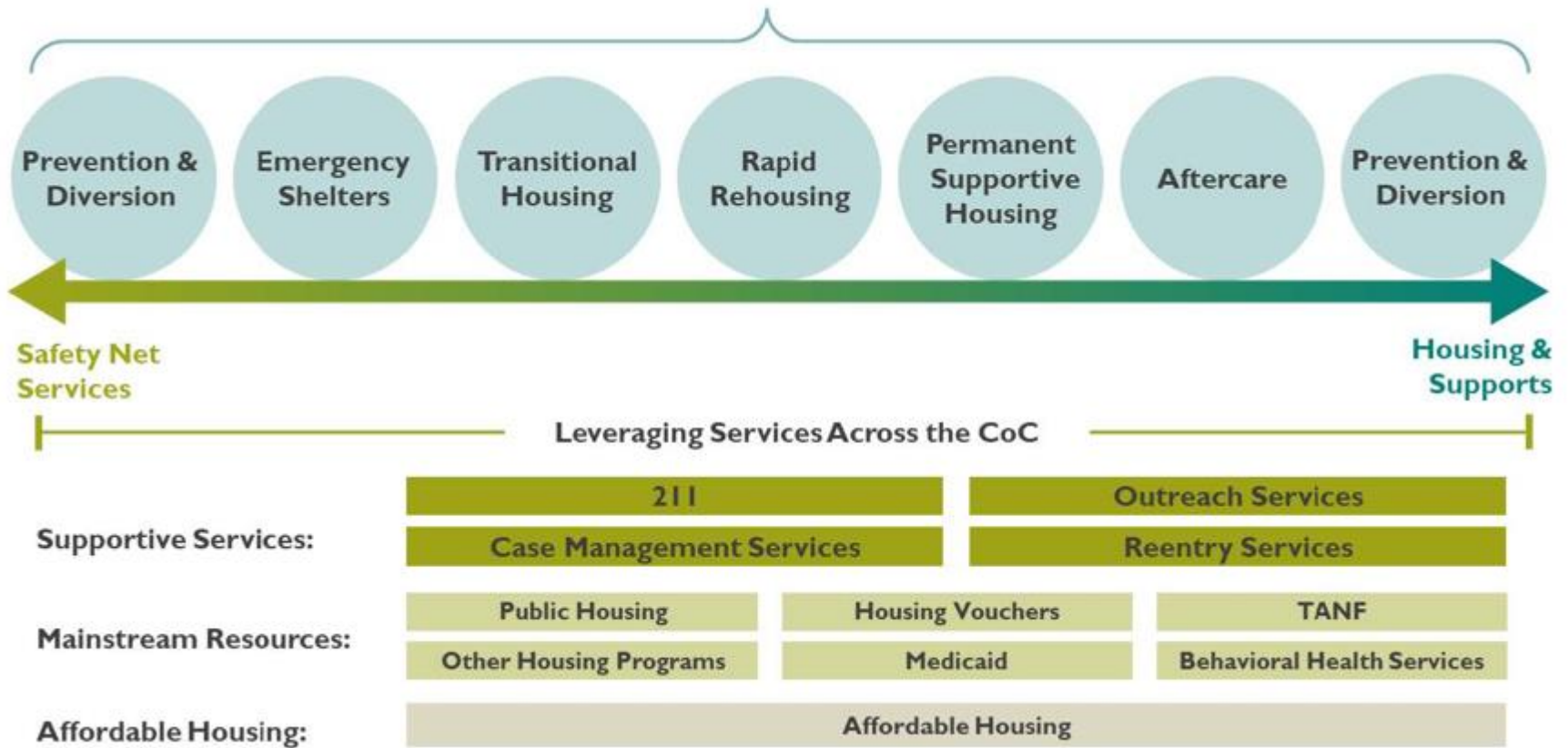


CoC Responsibilities



- Homeless Response System- “The Continuum”
 - Convene key stakeholders
 - Perform assessment of community need
- Coordinated Entry
 - Centralized list of everyone experiencing homelessness
 - Directs clients to appropriate resources
- Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)
 - Database

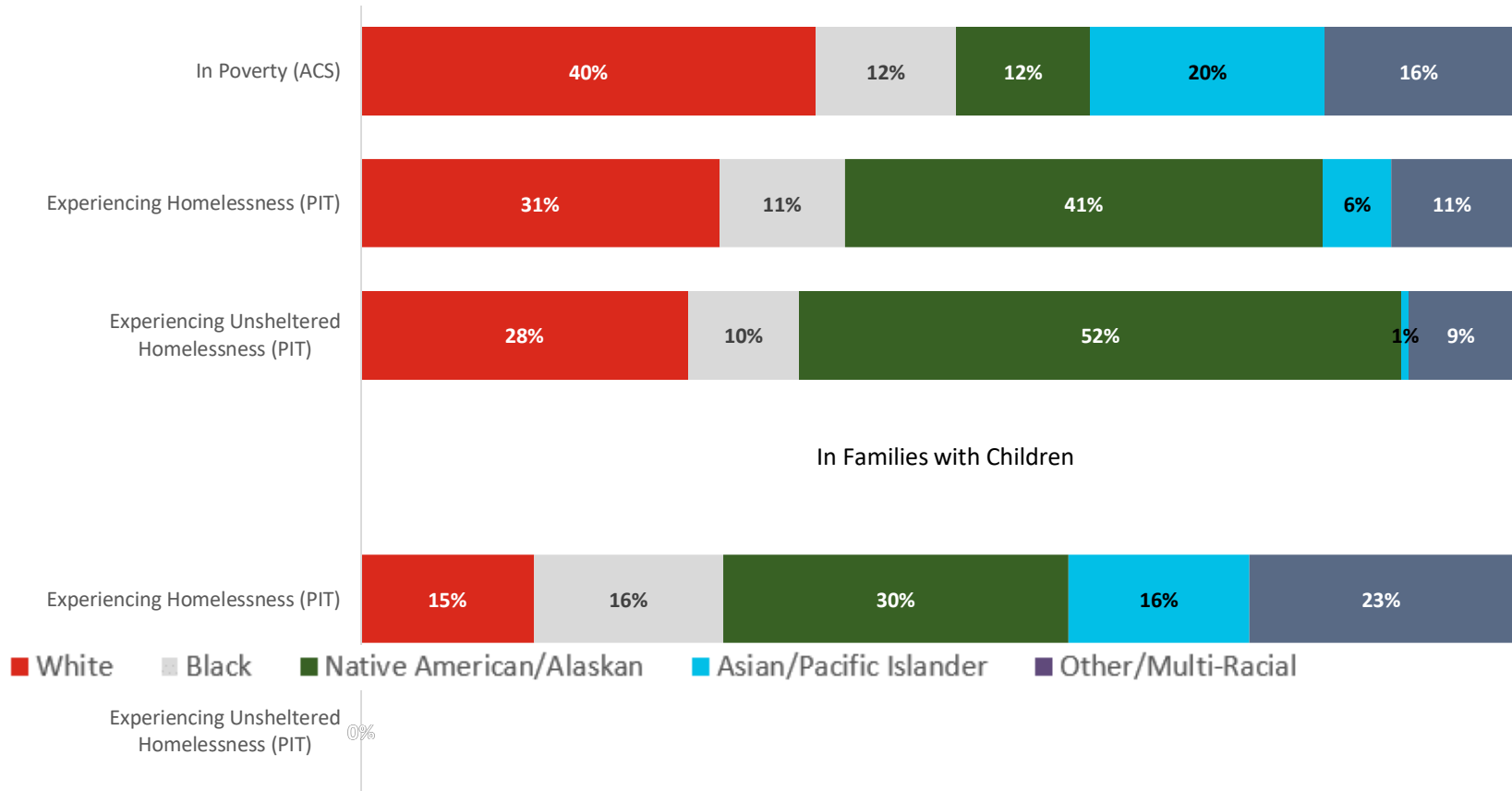

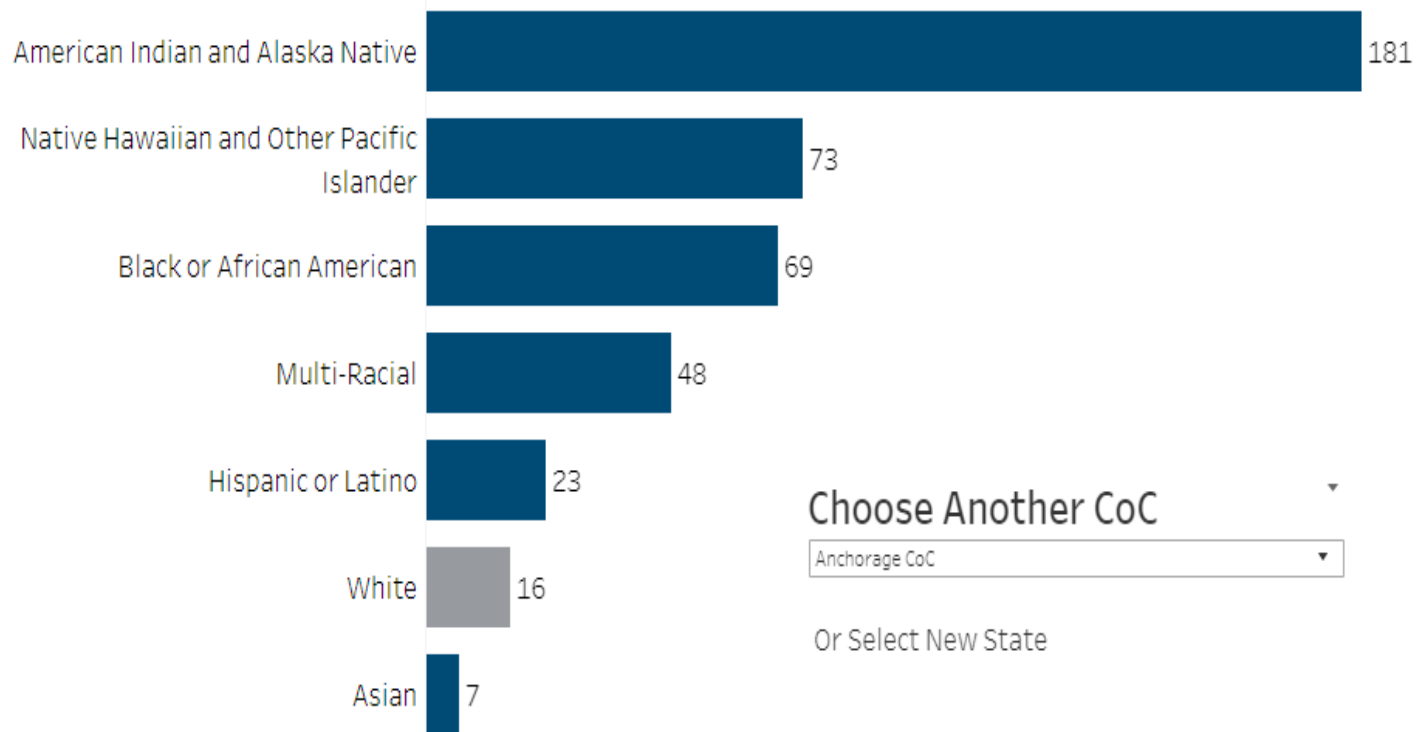

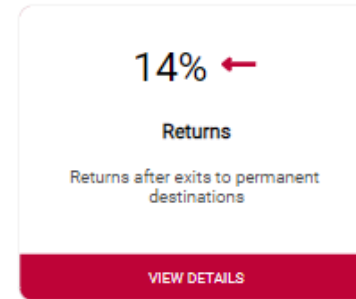
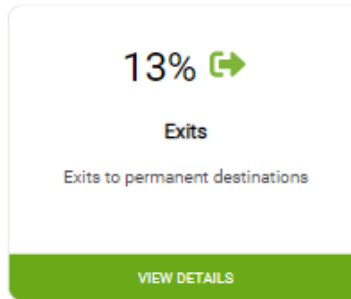
System Performance Overview

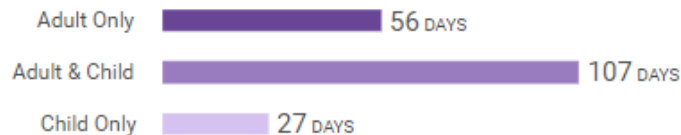
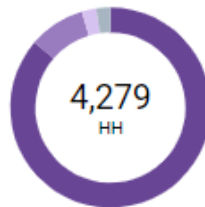


System Performance by Household Type

NOFA Terms

- Collaborative Application-
 - Community wide input
 - Submitted by ACEH to HUD
 - Impacts level of funding
- Local Project Application
 - Submitted by applicants to ACEH
 - Goes through Rank and Review Process
- Rank and Review (R&R)
 - Committee that evaluates project applicants and Tiers Projects
- Project Application-
 - Once an application has been selected by R&R, applicant submits second application to HUD in e-snaps

- **July 5th**: Anc. CoC Announcement of FY19 NOFA
- **Week of July 22nd**: First FY19 CoC Meeting / Local App. Released
- **Mondays**: Weekly CoC Application Meetings
- **Week of August 19th**: Local Application Due
- **Week of September 3rd**: Ranking and Review Released
- **September 30th**: Application due to HUD (Goal: 27th)

Categories of Homelessness

- Category 1
 - Literally homeless
- Category 2
 - Imminent Risk of Homelessness
- Category 3
 - Homeless under other Federal statutes
- Category 4
 - Fleeing/ Attempting to Flee DV

Eligible Applicants

- Meet HUD Eligibility requirements (non-profit status, etc.)
- Demonstrate financial and management capacity and experience
- Submit required certificates (e-snaps application)
- Population to be served meets eligibility requirements
- Commitment to use HMIS

Available to Fund

- Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
 - New and Renewal Programs
 - Funding for Categories 1, 2, and 4 homelessness
- Rapid Re-Housing and Joint TH-RRH
 - Serve categories 1, 2, and 4 homelessness
- Dedicated Plus programs
 - Chronic
 - In TH and met chronic upon entering
 - Entered housing within last 12 months and met chronic upon entering
 - Residing in Joint TH-RRH and met chronic upon entering
 - Residing in shelter, but not 4 separate occurrences- meets disability status
 - Receiving support through VA and met one of above upon entering

New Project Funding

- Funded through DV Bonus, CoC Bonus, or Reallocation
- 18 month initial terms optional
- Can fund PSH, RRH, Joint TH-RRH, SSO- CE

DV Bonus Project

- AK-500 Bonus Available: \$126,499
- Funding Uses:
 - Rapid Re-Housing programs
 - Joint TH-RRH
 - Coordinated Entry for DV
- Applicants go through normal R&R process
- Population
 - HUD Category 4
